#### Vendor Due Diligence: What to Look Out for?



- Deep discounts
- Over agreeing
- Data storage GDPR/MiFID
- Examine any exclusions in service level agreements (SLA)
- Will development activities be supported?
- Consider the quality of the people assigned to your organisation
- Background checks what do they check for?
- Ensure that the outsourcing team possesses industry expertise


